# Justice for Palestine Program

## Knowledge That Shapes Decision-Making



### About the Program:

The Justice for Palestine Graduate Scholarship Program is a strategic national initiative launched by the **Isnad Foundation for the Support of the Palestinian Student (IFPSS)**. It aims to develop outstanding Palestinian competencies in critical fields such as Political Science, International Relations, and International Law. **The program offers 200 fully funded scholarships for master's and doctoral students** from both within Palestine and the diaspora, to study at prestigious Palestinian, Arab, or international universities. The program aspires to empower Palestinian researchers to have a strong and influential presence in the international political and diplomatic arenas through applied scientific research, building an evidence-based Palestinian discourse, and contributing to the development of public and legal policies related to the Palestinian cause.

### Why the Justice for Palestine Scholarship Program?



#### WEAK PALESTINIAN REPRESENTATION IN INTERNATIONAL FORUMS

Palestinians suffer from a lack of effective presence in international institutions, leading to diminished influence of the Palestinian cause in shaping global decisions.



#### LACK OF SPECIALIZED PROFESSIONALS IN POLITICAL SCIENCE AND INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

Palestine faces a shortage of academically qualified individuals trained in political and diplomatic work, limiting its ability to influence regional and international policy.



#### LOW INVESTMENT IN POLITICAL AND DIPLOMATIC EDUCATION

Political science and international relations are not prioritized in Palestinian educational policy, resulting in a scarcity of academic programs and specialized research centers.



#### WEAK LINK BETWEEN ACADEMIC RESEARCH AND POLICY-MAKING

Academic research in political science often remains disconnected from decision-making bodies, reducing its potential to contribute to evidence-based and impactful political discourse.



#### ABSENCE OF YOUTH POLITICAL PARTICIPATION PROGRAMS

Palestine lacks structured programs that empower youth to engage in political and diplomatic spheres, creating a gap in preparing the next generation of leaders.



#### CHALLENGES FACING THE PALESTINIAN NARRATIVE IN GLOBAL MEDIA

The Palestinian cause is frequently targeted by distortion campaigns, while there is a lack of skilled professionals capable of defending it through legal and academic discourse in media and international platforms.

### OUR GOALS

- Enhancing the production of Palestinian political and legal knowledge and linking it to international decision-making processes.
- Providing 200 scholarships to outstanding Palestinian students in the fields of Political Science, International Relations, and International Law.
- Developing specialized academic cadres to strengthen Palestinian representation and contribute to defending national rights in global forums.

### The Justice for Palestine Scholarship Program Offers Financial Support Through Two Main Pillars:



**University Tuition Coverage:** Full coverage of tuition fees across various academic disciplines, **with an average annual support of \$3,000 per student.**



**Monthly Financial Support:** A monthly stipend averaging \$200 to cover students' basic needs such as housing and transportation, **totaling \$2,400 per year.**
