Investing in today’s medical students... to build the doctors of tomorrow
Isnad Foundation for Supporting Palestinian Student launches a humanitarian, professional campaign directed at doctors around the world. Its aim is to sponsor a group of outstanding medical students in the Gaza Strip—students who continue their studies under extremely difficult conditions despite their exceptional academic abilities.

This campaign does not offer “charity” or “assistance.”

It opens the road ahead for the future doctor whose stethoscope will save patients, heal, innovate, and represent Palestine with professionalism and excellence.

Why are we asking you, the doctors, to sponsor a medical student?

- Because the doctor understands better than anyone: the value of ensuring that a medical student finds someone who believes in them.
- Because guidance and support play a decisive role in shaping a successful doctor.
- Because investing in a medical student today is investing in thousands of patients tomorrow.
- Because the future doctor is capable of becoming a leader in the healthcare sector, a researcher, or a trainer for the next generations.

Whom do we sponsor?

The program targets exclusively:

- Academically outstanding medical students
- Students with proven professional commitment
- Students with a clear academic and professional vision
- Students who participate in medical or community activities

These are students who possess readiness, ambition, and the potential to become part of a long-term professional project.

We invest in creating future Palestinian doctors who can contribute to the advancement of Palestine’s healthcare sector.



What Does the “Sponsor a Medical Student in Gaza” Campaign Provide?

Supporting institutions — especially medical organizations — offer three main forms of support:

1) Tuition Coverage

Covering one academic semester or a full academic year, enabling the student to continue their studies despite the severe economic situation in Gaza.

2) Monthly Stipend (150–200 USD)

To cover: transportation, basic living expenses, and essential educational needs.

3) Educational Device Grant (Laptop / Tablet)

A device essential for today's medical education, used for:

Research , Medical references , Lectures , Simulations , Online exams

Especially important after many universities in Gaza shifted to online or hybrid learning due to infrastructure challenges.

This support opens a door toward academic excellence, widening the student's opportunities in study and training.

How do we present the student to the supporting doctor?

Isnad Foundation provides a complete academic and professional profile of the student, including:

- Academic performance and GPA
- Medical and research activities
- Level of commitment and discipline
- Personal circumstances and justification for support

We then match the supporting doctor with a student who aligns with their interest in contributing to shaping the future of Palestine's healthcare sector.

The Impact of the Campaign on the Palestinian Health Sector

- Empowering a select group of outstanding medical students.
- Contributing to improving the quality of medical education in Gaza.
- Preparing a new generation with strong professional and humanitarian values.
- Building a network of doctors who support Palestinian medical students.
